Responsibilities and Duties:

<u>Commercial Field Work for Two Semesters</u>. Employee is expected to rotate between commercial sheet metal, commercial piping and industrial piping crews.

- Load and unload tools, material, and equipment.
- Stage, organize, and inventory materials and equipment for project.
- Aid in the layout and installation of mechanical equipment, ductwork, and piping.
- Assist in the setting of equipment with the aid of a crane, boom truck, forklift, or other construction vehicles.
- Daily clean-up and housekeeping of jobsites, vehicles, and work area.
- Overtime or varied shift work hours may be required.
